## As the weather turns cooler and we spend more time indoors, here are some easy ways to conserve water at home and save on your bills.

- Replace old toilets with more efficient, low-flow toilets.
- Install water efficient faucets throughout the house to make your home conservation friendly.
- Fix leaks. Small household leaks can add up to gallons of water lost every day.
- Turn off the tap while brushing your teeth.
- Keep a pitcher of drinking water in the refrigerator instead of running the faucet until the water is cool.
- Thaw foods in the refrigerator overnight rather than thawing with water.
- Wash only full loads of laundry or use the appropriate water level or load size selection on the washing machine.
- Wash fruits and vegetables in bowls of water, not under running water.

## Stop the drain on your dollars! Check your toilet twice a year.

A leaky toilet can waste up to 20 cubic metres a day or more than 600 cubic metres in a month. Perform this simple leak test to save money and water.

1. **Wait 10 minutes after the last flush cycle.**
2. **Put a few droplets of food colouring or leak tablets available at Lakefront's office into the toilet tank. Do not flush.**
3. **Wait 15 minutes.**
4. **If the dye colour appears in the toilet bowl, you have a leak.**

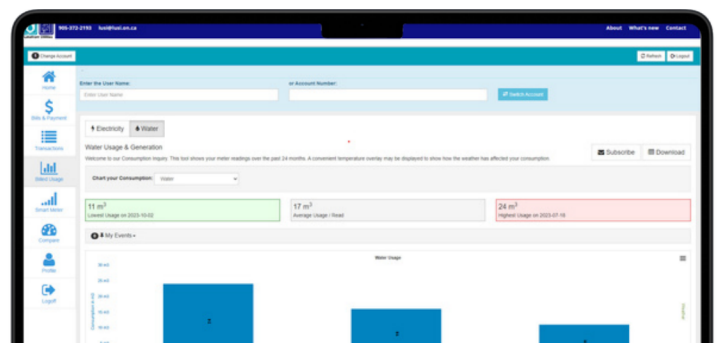
